

# Reminder: NYRx Preferred Diabetic Supply Program (PDSP)

May 16, 2023

## What Providers Need to Know

On April 1, 2023, coverage of diabetic supplies transitioned from the Medicaid managed care plans to NYRx, the Medicaid Pharmacy Program. This transition requires members who are not currently on a preferred diabetic supply be switched to a preferred product included in the NYRx Preferred Diabetic Supply Program (PDSP). NYRx will allow a one-time transition fill of a non-preferred supply between April 1, 2023-June 30, 2023. After that members should be switched to products listed on the PDSP List.
