

# NYRx Drug Class Coverage Overview: HIV Post-Exposure Prophylaxis Agents

# NYRx Drugs Covered for Post-Exposure Prophylaxis to Prevent HIV Infection

As outlined in the New York State Department of Health AIDS Institute <u>Post-Exposure Prophylaxis (PEP)</u> to <u>Prevent HIV Infection Clinical Guidelines</u>, the following drugs can be used for HIV PEP:

- Cimduo (lamivudine / tenofovir disoproxil fumarate)
- Emtriva (emtricitabine)
- Epivir, Epivir HBV (lamivudine)
- Isentress (raltegravir)
- Kaletra (lopinavir / ritonavir)
- Lexiva (fosamprenavir)
- Norvir (ritonavir)
- Retrovir (zidovudine)
- Reyataz (atazanavir)
- Stribild (elvitegravir, cobicistat, emtricitabine, and tenofovir disoproxil fumarate)
- Tivicay (dolutegravir)
- Truvada (emtricitabine / tenofovir)
- Viread (tenofovir)

## What Pharmacy Providers Need to Do

Pharmacy providers should bill PEP agents for a 28-day supply.

## What Prescribers Need to Do

Prescribers should write a prescription for a 28-day supply of PEP. A prior authorization is not required if the prescription is written for a 28-day supply, there is no diagnosis of HIV and no HIV drugs in the members history in the last 120 days.
