

# NYRx Notice to Prescribers: Prior Authorization Submission Requirements

# **Background**

The NYRx Clinical Call Center is receiving a high volume of prior authorization (PA) requests via fax with incomplete and/or missing information, resulting in slower processing time for everyone. This notice is to remind prescribers what information to include when submitting a PA to NYRx, the Medicaid Pharmacy Program. In addition, NYRx offers several drug classes and drug-specific PA worksheets to help prescribers with providing the necessary medical information for PA submission.

# **Required Information for Prior Authorization Submission**

Both fax and phone requests require the prescriber or their authorized agent to provide the following:

- Member's name
- Member's date of birth
- Member's Medicaid client identification number (CIN)
- Prescriber's name
- Prescriber's national provider identifier (NPI)
- Prescriber's phone number
- Prescriber's fax number
- Drug being requested (name, strength, direction, quantity, and refills)

### **Prior Authorization Submission Worksheets**

There are several drug class or drug-specific PA worksheets available to prescribers when submitting a PA. These worksheets are located <u>here</u>. It is recommended to use these worksheets for fax and phone submission, as the clinical information for review is consistent for both at the NYRx Clinical Call Center.
