



NYRx 90-Day Supply Update

November 26, 2024

Background

The purpose of this notice is to update providers that NYRx, the Medicaid Pharmacy Program allows 90-day supplies of most maintenance medications and over-the-counter drugs. By allowing 90-day supplies, NYRx is reducing the administrative burden for prescribers and pharmacies, improving patient medication adherence and health outcomes, increasing convenience, and reducing copay costs for members.

Our records indicate you care for a large volume of New York State (NYS) Medicaid members who are eligible to receive a 90-day supply.

Note: Most non-controlled prescriptions have up to a one-year fill (original and three refills if prescribing 90-day supplies).

90-Day Supply Eligible Drugs

Up to a 90-day supply per fill is available for most maintenance medications when the member has been stabilized and taking their medication on a consistent basis, and there are no concerns about storage of the extended supply. A maintenance medication is a medication taken on a regular basis, often daily, to treat an ongoing or chronic condition or illness, including but not limited to:

- Asthma
- Depression
- Diabetes
- High Blood Pressure
- High Cholesterol
- Mild Pain

What Prescribers Need to Do

Please consider prescribing 90-day supplies for your Medicaid patients who are established on a drug and dose of maintenance medication or OTC drug.
