

# NYRx Drug Coverage Overview: Trelegy Ellipta®

## **NYRx Preferred Drug List**

The Preferred Drug Program (PDP) promotes the use of less expensive, equally effective drugs within specific drug classes when medically appropriate. Drugs subject to the PDP are listed on the <a href="NYRx">NYRX</a>
<a href="Preferred Drug List">Preferred Drug List (PDL)</a>.

Trelegy Ellipta® is a combination of fluticasone furoate, an inhaled corticosteroid (ICS); umeclidinium, an anticholinergic; and vilanterol, a long-acting beta2-adrenergic agonist (LABA). Trelegy Ellipta® is **non-preferred** and will require a PA. The following alternative agents are <u>preferred</u> and can be used in combination for your Medicaid members without a PA:

- Arnuity Ellipta® BLTG (fluticasone furoate)
- Anoro Ellipta® BLTG (umeclidinium and vilanterol)

Please note, both Arnuity Ellipta® and Anoro Ellipta® are a part of the <u>NYRx Brand Less Than Generic Program (BLTG)</u>. The pharmacy should dispense the brand name product and **not** submit a PA request to the provider's office for a generic of a BLTG drug.

### What Pharmacy Providers and Prescribers Need to Do

Pharmacy providers and prescribers should become familiar with the <u>NYRx Preferred Drug Quick List</u> and incorporate this information when deciding what to prescribe for Medicaid members.
