Delay in Change to Medicaid Fee For Service (FFS) Pharmacy Professional Dispensing Fee

The November 1, 2018 effective date of the change to the Medicaid FFS Pharmacy Professional Dispensing Fee has been delayed to November 5, 2018.

Effective November 5, 2018, based on the enacted budget and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) state plan approval (<u>https://www.health.ny.gov/regulations/state_plans/status/non-inst/approved/docs/app_2018-09-05_spa_18-22.pdf</u>), the FFS pharmacy professional dispensing fee will be revised from \$10.00 to \$10.08 for covered outpatient drugs, when applicable.

Retroactive adjustments back to April 1, 2018 will be handled at a future date, which will be communicated to providers ahead of time. Such adjustments will be spread out over a period of time (to be determined) and will show on the remittance with claim level detail.
