New York State Medicaid Pharmacy Coverage of Polio Vaccine

Effective **September 9th, 2022** through **October 9th, 2022**, and in accordance with New York State (NYS) Governor Kathy Hochul's <u>Executive Order No. 21.0</u>, NYS Medicaid Fee-for-Service (FFS) and Medicaid Managed Care (MMC) Plans cover the inactivated poliovirus vaccine (IPV) for administration of IPV to Medicaid FFS and MMC members.

FFS Pharmacy Billing Guidance

The NYS FFS Medicaid program provides reimbursement to NYS Medicaid enrolled pharmacies for IPV vaccine administration and the acquisition cost. Pharmacies should not seek reimbursement for the IPV vaccine when acquired at no cost.

Pharmacies should submit a claim using the National Council for Prescription Drug Program (NCPDP) D.O format described below:

Submit the CPT code of the vaccine "90713" in field 407-D7 (Product/Service ID).
