

NYRx, the Medicaid Pharmacy Program: Prior Authorization Update

On May 15, 2025, the New York State Medicaid Drug Utilization Review Board (DURB) recommended changes to NYRx, the Medicaid Pharmacy Program. The Commissioner of Health has reviewed the recommendations of the DURB and has approved the following changes.

The following drug classes were reviewed and effective **November 6, 2025**, prior authorization (PA) requirements may change in the following Preferred Drug Program (PDP) drug classes:

- Anti-Virals Oral
- Beta Blockers
- Antimigraine Agents Other
- Antipsychotics Second Generation
- Sedative Hypnotics / Sleep Agents
- Glucagon Agents
- Insulin Rapid-Acting
- Colony Stimulating Factors
- Hemophilia Agents Other
- Platelet Inhibitors
- Prostaglandin Agents Ophthalmic
- Alpha Reductase Inhibitors for BPH
- Urinary Tract Antispasmodics
- COPD Agents

Effective **December 1, 2025**, coverage will change for the following over-the-counter (OTC) products:

• Over-the-counter products containing Aluminum Chloride will be removed from the Medicaid Pharmacy List of Reimbursable Drugs.

Electronic prior authorization requests are now accepted by NYRx, the Medicaid Pharmacy Program, via CoverMyMeds.
